25-26 OCS Student Dress Code

TOPS: Polo shirts in white, red, or blue.

BOTTOMS:

- Shorts, jeans, and pants in navy blue, black, or khaki
- No holes (rips or tears) allowed in pants or jeans
- Shorts/skirts/jumpers must be no higher than 3 inches above the knees

GIRLS ONLY: Dresses and jumpers in navy blue, black, or khaki

OUTERWEAR: Solid white, blue, red, or black sweatshirt, hoodie, zippered hoodie, or cardigan

<u>FOOTWEAR:</u>

- Shoes must have rubber soles and must not leave scuff marks on the floor. (No music or rollers)
- Must be able to be safely worn in PE
- Crocs may be worn as long as they are closed-toed. (No jibbiz allowed)
- Ugg-style boots are allowed as long as they follow all the above rules.

FRIDAY ONLY: Students may wear a school-approved spirit shirt in place of their polo.

FREE DRESS FRIDAYS:

The last Friday of each month students may wear clothes of their choice as long as they meet these school guidelines:

- No holes (rips or tears) allowed in pants or jeans
- Shorts/skirts/jumpers must be no higher than 3 inches above the knees
- Sleeveless jerseys are permitted only with a t-shirt under them
- No cropped shirts. (no skin showing between shirt and pants)
- School-appropriate hats may be worn but must be removed during chapel.
- No leggings or jeggings
- No pajamas
- No vulgar language or imagery allowed
